### Activities

A one day seminar was held on 5 October, 2017, at the home of the Northampton Town Football Club. The event, which was sponsored by Cloud Sustainability, Bywaters, Olleco, Sharpsmart, GV Health and Econix was attended by 67 delegates.

The work shadowing scheme for students continued. The scheme entails students spending two days work shadowing various operations within the organisation. In 2017, two 'work shadows' took place. One was held in conjunction with SRCL, by a final year Waste Management student, Stephen Angue, and the second with Grundon, by a final year Geography student, Becky Jenkins.
